It helps you respond to your child’s needs in ways that build connection and support positive behavior. Circle of Security™-Parenting gives children a stronger sense of security and confidence so they can explore, learn, and grow.



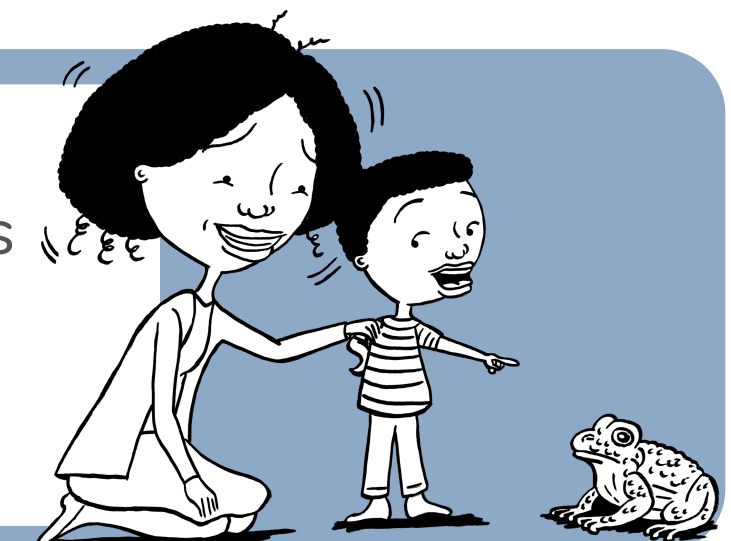
WHO SHOULD ATTEND:



Circle of Security™-Parenting is a parenting class for any parent, grandparent, kinship, adoptive, and long-term foster parents, as well as any professional caring working with children. The program is designed for caregivers with children ages birth up to 12 years of age.

WHERE THE CLASSES ARE HELD:

Circle of Security Parenting has continued to expand its reach across communities throughout Nebraska. There are 346 trained facilitators across 51 counties. Classes are held in-person and on Zoom all across the state.



WHAT LANGUAGES ARE OFFERED:



Aside from English, Nebraska facilitators are able to offer the COSP program in many other languages including: Arabic, Dari, Mandarin Chinese, Karen, Pashto, Spanish, Thai, and Vietnamese.

HOW DOES COSP STAND OUT?

Grounded in decades of attachment research, COSP strengthens the parent–child relationship through a trauma-informed, culturally responsive approach. Using guided reflection, it helps parents consider how their own experiences shape their parenting and provides a clear map of children’s emotional needs.

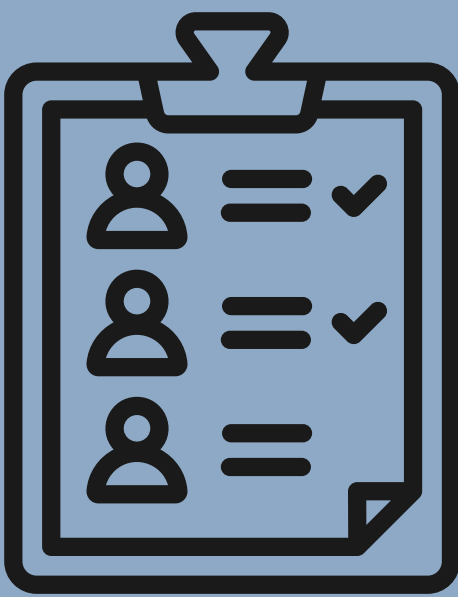
SERVICE DETAILS



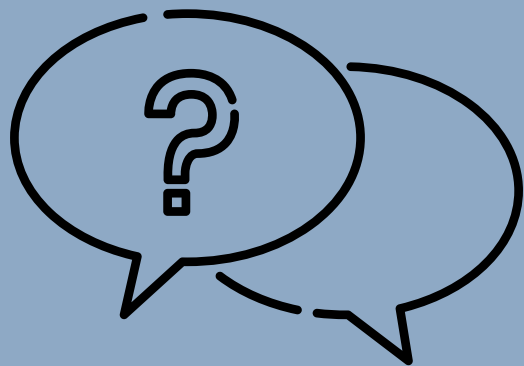
1 occurrence per week for 8 weeks

After the service referral is submitted through the
